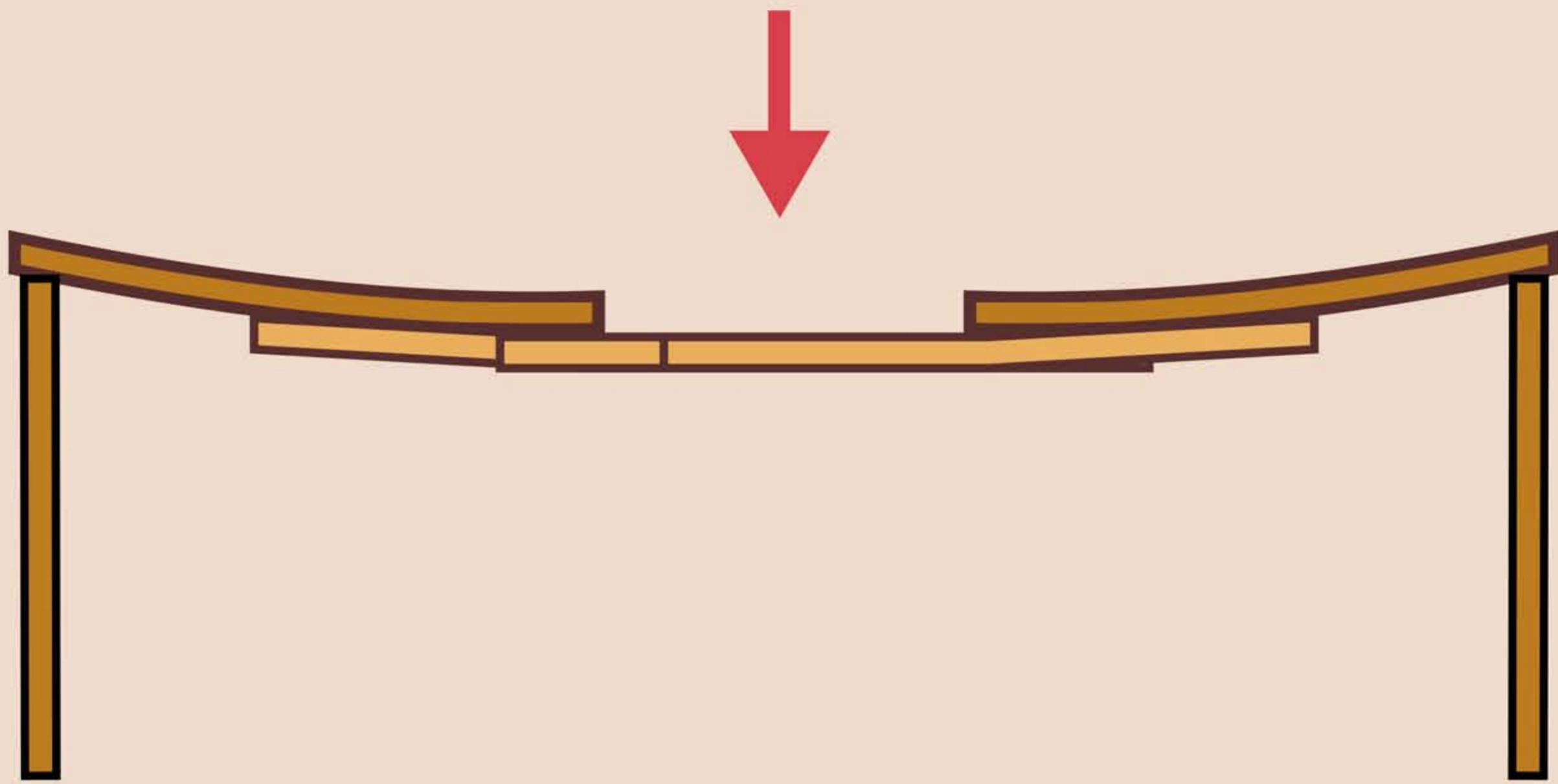


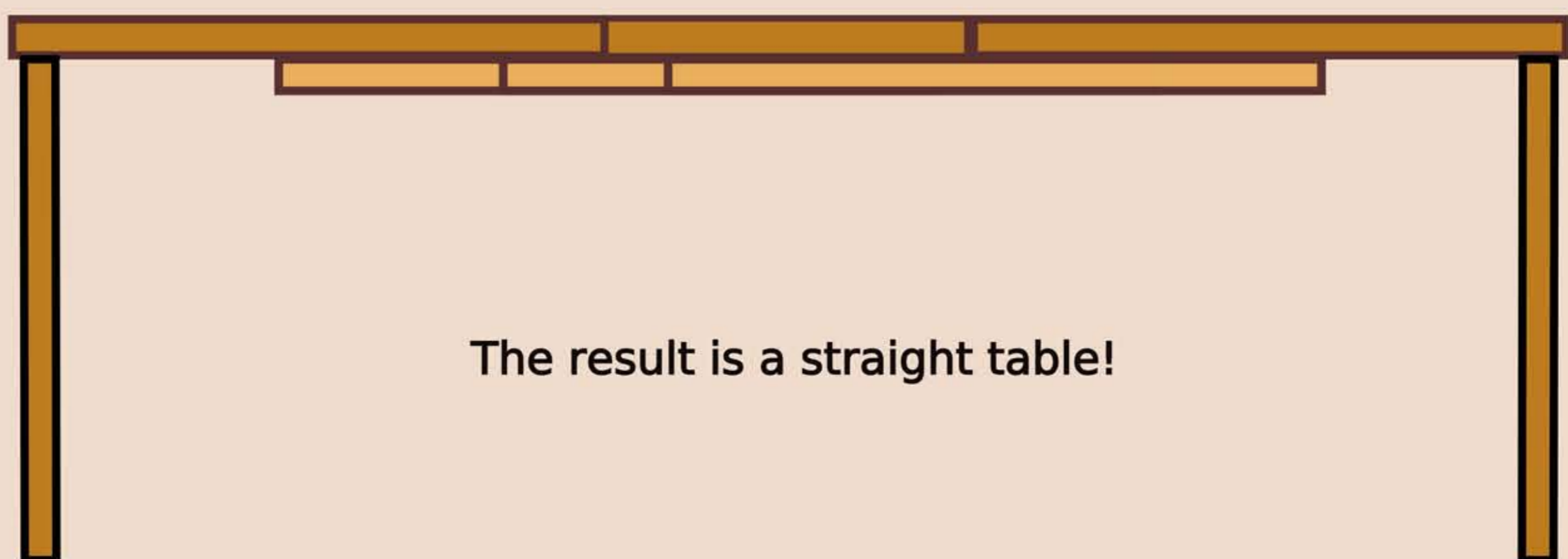
How does a Waterville slide compensate for natural sagging on a 4 legged type table ?



When opening, the legs of a 4 legged type table get farther apart, causing a sagging effect in the center of the table



While opening, the Waterville slide manufactured for a 4 legged type table develops a camber to compensate the natural sagging at the center of the table



The result is a straight table!
