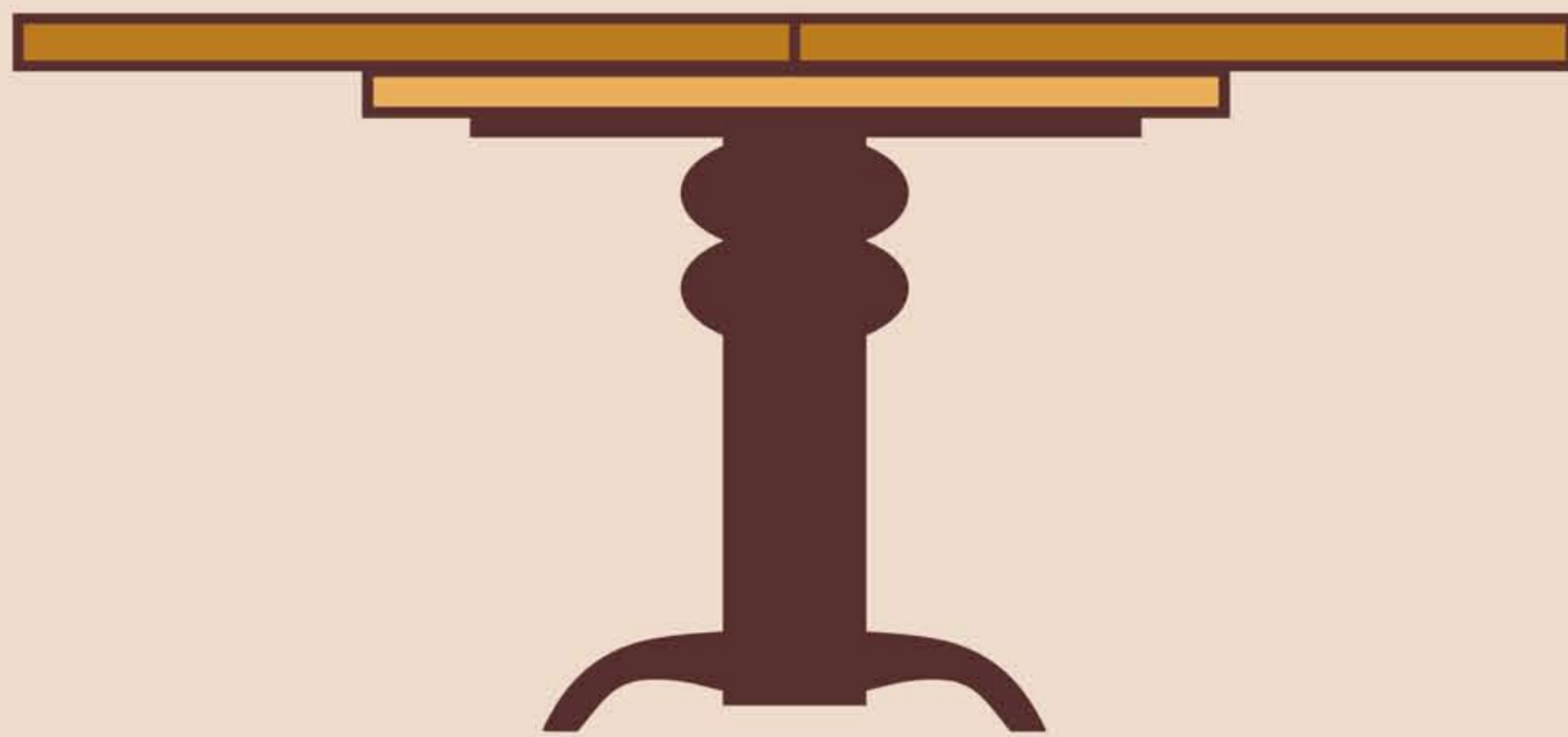
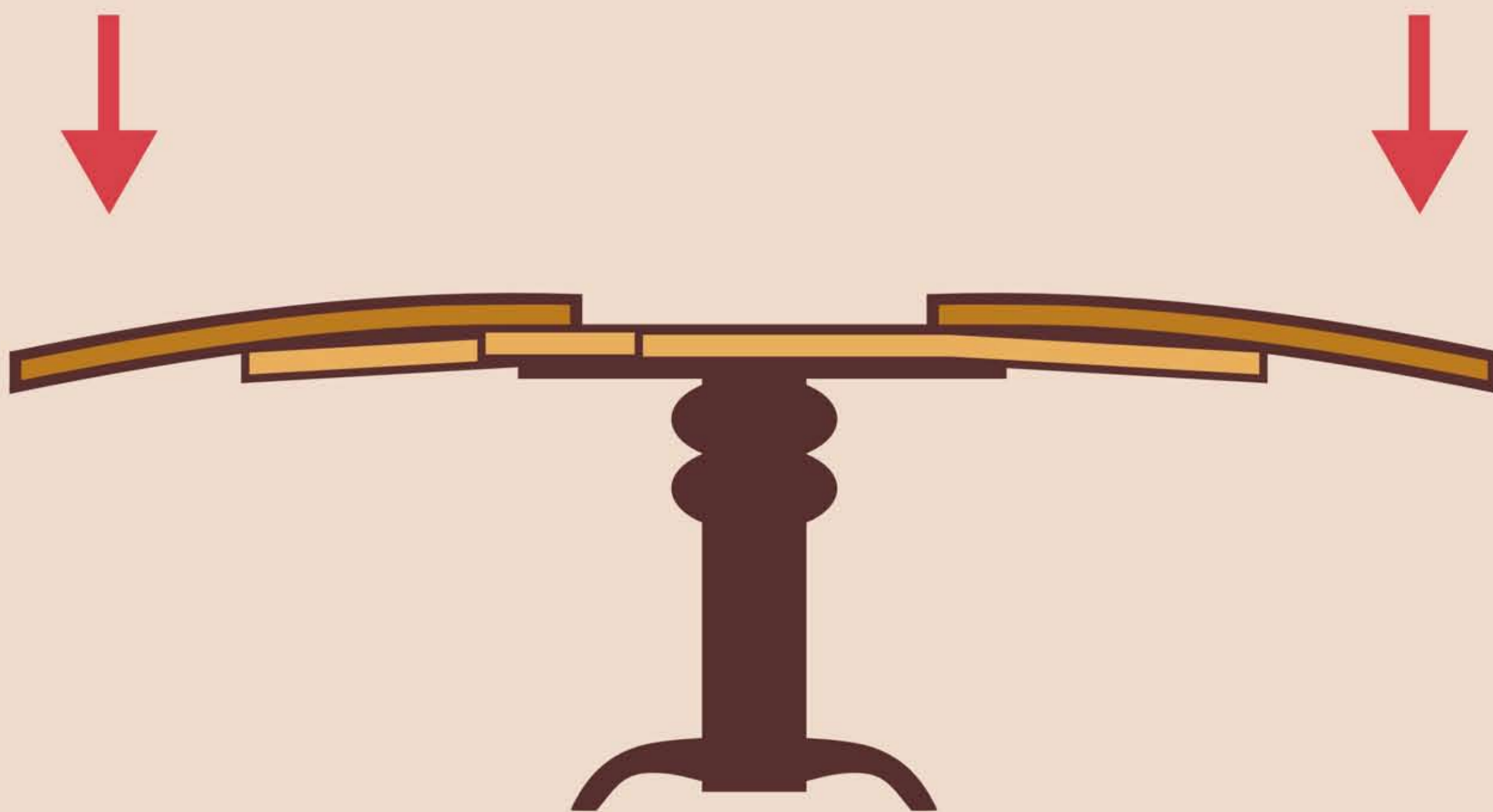


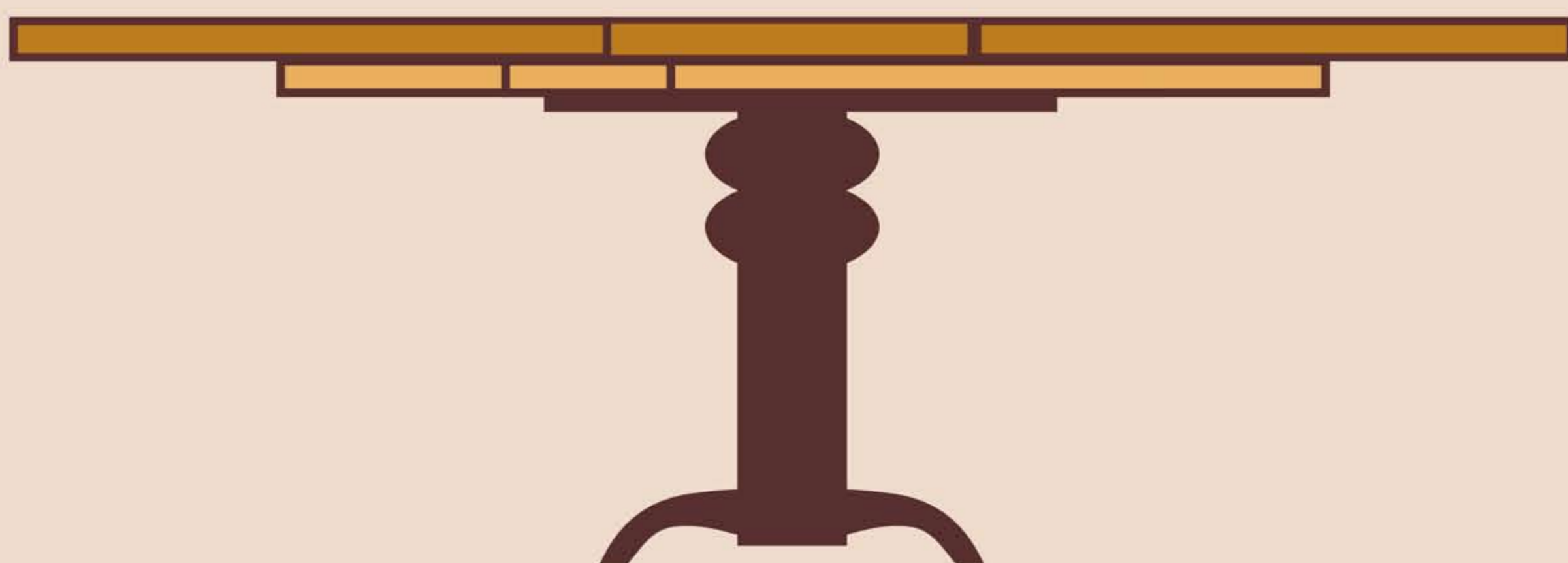
How does a Waterville slide compensate for natural sagging on a pedestal type table ?



When opening, the table top extremities of a pedestal type table get farther away from the central support end tend to sag



While opening, the Waterville slide manufactured for a pedestal type table develops a camber to compensate the natural sagging at the ends of the table



The result is a straight table!
